Task Force on Implementation of the Mining Policy Framework**

Objective

To prepare a Programme of Work for implementation of the Mining Policy Framework.

Parameters

- The Task Force will operate between the 2011 and 2013 General Sessions.
- The Task Force will identify ways in which the Forum, working in collaboration with UNCTAD and with other stakeholders in the industry, can assist its Member countries as well as selected Observer countries, to implement the Mining Policy Framework.
- In this process, the Task Force will give particular attention to outreach to other stakeholders in the mining industry, including EITI, mining industry associations, civil-society organizations, and bodies such as the World Economic Forum. The Task Force will also identify opportunities for regionally-oriented activities.
- The three priority themes which the Task Force will address are
 - Legal and policy environment
 - Social / economic benefit and community engagement
 - Financial benefit optimization / Transparency
- The Task Force will also give attention to the following themes
 - Artisanal and small-scale mining
 - Environmental Management
 - Post-mining transition
- The Task Force will issue an interim report to the 2012 General Session.
