Realising Principle 10 of the Rio Declaration on Access to Information, Public Participation and Access to Remedy in Environmental Matters

- Integrate the substance of environmental and human rights standards into policies, laws and regulations
- Actively engage the affected public
- Put in place mechanisms for holding government and mining companies accountable

UNDP's work on extractive industries for sustainable development

- Development Minerals programme in African, Caribbean and Pacific states, funded by the EU: improving livelihoods by upgrading mineral value chains
- Environmental Governance of Mining programme, funded by Swedish SIDA: integrated mining policies with human rights, environment and gender
- Partnership with the African Union – strengthening capacities to advance the African Mining Vision, knowledge generation to support resource-based industrialization
- Advocacy, awareness raising – companies to integrate SDGs in business & social investments; new issues – halting impacts on forests, biodiversity
